The nominees are evaluated on their commitment to Vision 2030: A Roadmap for California Community Colleges, and equitable student outcomes; professional ethics and standards; serving the institution's diverse student population through participation in professional and/or community activities; and serving as a leader beyond their location institution.

Recipients will be announced and honored at the May 20 meeting of the Board of Governors.
